We thank our volunteers and appreciate their value in our work. Last fall the team that attended the Village to Village conference got a new perspective on the power of our volunteers.

We found that our operating budget and member fees are less than the average across the country and that the number and variety of our programs and services are significantly greater, per capita, than many villages. This productivity is made possible by the commitment of our volunteers. Between January and March, they contributed 449 service hours to our members! Add to that the 1,330 hours that members contribute to Board and Committee activity, and we have an average contribution of almost 600 hours per month! That's the equivalent of 15 people working full time. Imagine what our fees would be if we had to pay for all that time. Regardless of amount paid, it would be difficult to find staff that could be as responsive to the needs of our members as our volunteers are. In addition to countless rides and friendly visits, it's the ability of office volunteers to contact just the right person for an unusual request and the willingness of our service volunteers to say "Sure, I'll try to help" that allow us to meet diverse needs. In the past quarter volunteers helped a member select a new mattress, walked the Mall as part of a friendly visit, completed numerous handyman chores and hung a bird house! We also want to acknowledge volunteers who organize programs, help raise funds, manage our budget, keep our technology systems running, make presentations, welcome and orient new members. These folks are an often invisible but vital backbone of TVIH. The Village wouldn't exist without all of you!!

Beware!! Potential Medicare Scam

In April 2018, Medicare will begin a year-long project to replace all current Medicare cards by converting to new alpha-numeric ID numbers. Currently the ID number is your social security number. The new Medicare card will arrive in the mail. You don't need to request it or do anything; be aware that scam artists are seeking to swindle the unsuspecting public.

How? Scammers claiming to be from "Medicare" will call to inform you that a new Medicare card is being mailed, but until it arrives you will need a temporary card at a cost of \$5 - \$50. They ask for personal information, bank account or credit card to process the temporary card. It's a SCAM!! Medicare will never call you; most communication is by mail unless you ask them to call. 
